

# SEPTEMBER 2011 OESD EMBROIDERY CLUB INSTRUCTIONS

## DIRECTIONS FOR HAPPY THANKSGIVING DESIGN

1. This is an appliqué design.
2. Mark the center point of your fabric.
3. Thread your machine with regular bobbin thread and an embroidery 11 needle
4. Bring up the Happy Thanksgiving design #GNHL85501
5. If you are using cotton fabric, hoop 1 layer of tearaway stabilizer and your fabric. OR, hoop your fabric and float 1 layer of tearaway.
6. Make sure the needle starting point is on target.
7. Stitch out the design in sequence
8. The design calls for 15 color changes, and 13 different colors
  - 1) **Yellow**
  - 2) **Pale yellow**
  - 3) **Cocoa Brown**
  - 4) **Orange**
  - 5) **Burnt Orange**
  - 6) **Yellow**
  - 7) **Cocoa Brown**
  - 8) **Green Dust**
  - 9) **Yellow Green**
  - 10) **Purple**
  - 11) **Pale Violet**
  - 12) **Red**
  - 13) **Sienna**
  - 14) **Black**
  - 15) **Olive Drab**

## DIRECTIONS FOR MAKING THE FROG DESIGN # CM639\_48

1. Mark the center point of the base fabric.
2. Choose the correct stabilizer for your fabric choice. Tearaway works best with cotton
3. Hoop the stabilizer and fabric, or hoop the fabric and float one layer of stabilizer
4. Make sure the needle starting point is on target.
5. Stitch the first stitching outline—you may use the third stitching color--white
6. Place the scrap fabric on top of the outline and stitch #2
7. Remove the hoop from the sewing machine **BE CAREFUL NOT TO REMOVE THE FABRIC FROM THE HOOP.**
8. Trim the excess fabric to the stitching line.
9. Stitch the remaining colors #3 White #4 Green, #5 Black – or any colors you choose.
